How we promote democracy in the setting

- Open door Policy for parents and children.
- We develop children's critical thinking skills and support them to lead their own learning
- Children make choices about where they play in the continuous provision and whether they go inside or outside
- Children's interests are developed through inquiry groups and the environment is modified to reflect their interests and learning styles.
- Children develop their own friendships.
- Children are supported to be curious and independent learners.
- Children listen to each other and learn to take turns.

Respecting each others opinions

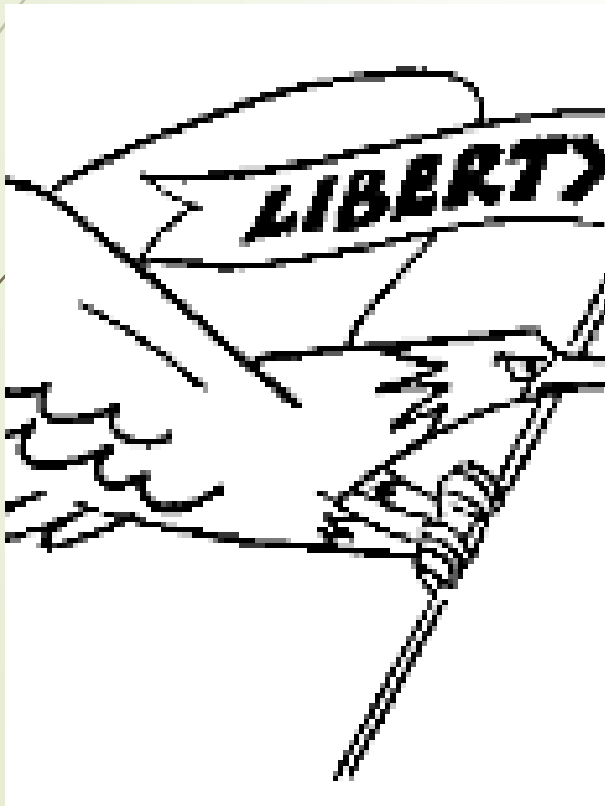
